



COVID 19 Decision Tree - STUDENTS

Yes, Student has symptoms with no alternative explanation or medical diagnosis

NO, Student does not have SYMPTOMS

Common Symptoms

- Fever
- Loss of smell or taste
- Cough
- Unexplained muscle aches
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath
- Chills
- New or unusual headache
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea or loss of appetite

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

- Notify administrator and stay home or if at school, student will be isolated and need to be picked up within 60 minutes
- Contact physician and follow medical care
- Obtain COVID-19 Test

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

- Contact Pastor (if applicable) & OCSC

Is Student aware of contact with someone who has been diagnosed with or tested positive for Covid-19?

Yes, there was direct physical or close contact (less than 6 feet) for 15 minutes or more where neither parties were using face masks or coverings.

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

- Notify administrator
- Keep child home and follow local school distance learning plan
- Contact child's physician and obtain Covid-19 Test
- Monitor by checking for fever and symptoms
- Follow directives for "If Student Tests positive" or "If Student Tests Negative"
- Return to school only after providing copy of negative test result or after 10 days have passed since contact

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

- Notify Pastor (if applicable) & OCSC
- Follow directives for "If Student Tests positive" or "If Student Tests Negative."

Yes, there was non-close contact (greater than 6 feet) and/or the contact lasted less than 15 minutes and/or face masks or coverings were used by one or both parties.

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

- Parents-monitor by checking for fever and symptoms.
- Continue practicing social distancing and good hygiene.
- Follow directives for "YES SYMPTOMS" if symptoms appear.

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

- No specific action is needed

No, the student is unaware of any contact with someone who is infected or diagnosed with Covid-19

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

- Continue practicing social distancing and good hygiene

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

- No specific action is needed

If Student Tests Positive

If Student Tests Negative

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

- Notify administrator of result
- Work with administrator to complete DOSP Contact Tracing Form
- Continue medical care as instructed
- Return to school only after: 24 hours have passed since recovery (No fever and improvement of respiratory symptoms) **AND** 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

- Notify Pastor (if applicable) & OCSC
- Notify teachers and students listed on the Contact Tracing Form.
- Implement school contingency plan if necessary, after consultation with local health department, Pastor, and OCSC
- Send general communication to staff and parent community

STUDENTS/PARENTS WILL

- Notify Administrator of result (copy of results to administrator)
- Continue medical care as instructed
- Return to school after 24 hours have passed since recovery (No fever and general improvement of symptoms)

ADMINISTRATOR WILL

- Notify Pastor (if applicable) & OCSC
